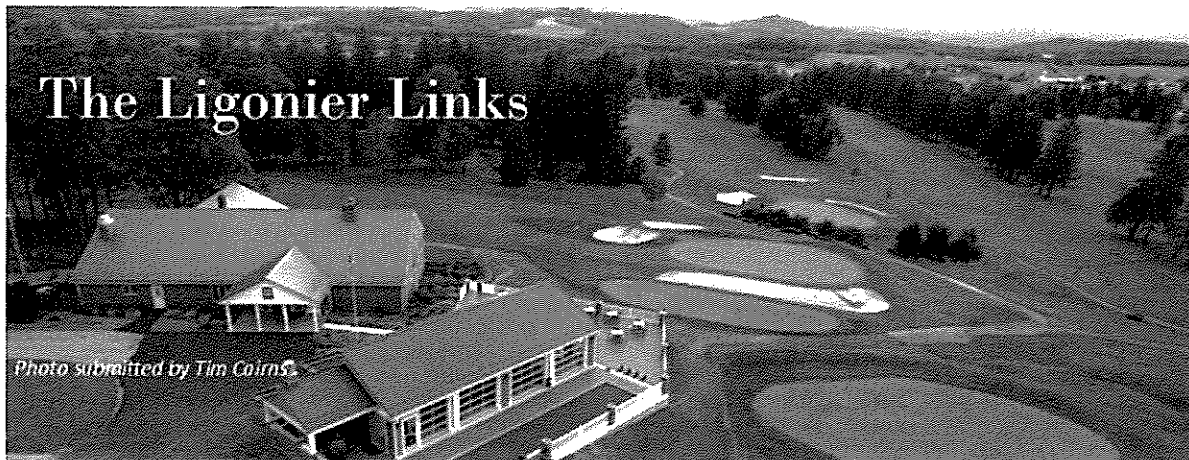

Usually this time of year we are asking you to not put away your clubs for fall, but I have a feeling many of you plan to play as long as you can this year and enjoy every bit of the outdoors.

Greens aerification is scheduled to begin Tuesday, September 15th. As long as the weather allows, the greens will be completed in two days and be healed in less than two weeks. We will be closing all facilities for the two days. Aerification is a necessary evil for golfers; it is a vital process to the health of the greens and with so much hard work to get the greens back, I'm sure you'll all appreciate the steps our crew must make to keep them rolling at their best.

We'd like to remind everyone that we are still under state guidelines regarding covid and will most likely be for the remainder of the season. This includes, but is not limited to:

- masks mandatory when moving around the facilities
- food purchase required for alcohol purchases
- limited times of gatherings (sitting after a meal is prohibited)
- limited seating available outside, so reservations are required for dining
- please continue to follow social distancing

The event was called off and will now be played on September 1. We still enjoyed a wonderful dinner planned by Becky DeMuth, who put great effort in to organizing the event.

Some changes have been made to the September schedule. The Pink Lady will now be played on September 8. Aeration of the course, originally slated to start that week, will now begin the week of September 14. September 15 and 22 will be No Gadget days. 30 or 40 balls will have to wait until next year.

A reminder that the closing day scramble will be a 1:00 p.m. shot gun on September 29. Based on positive feedback from last year, the plan is to have one orange tee player on each team. Dinner, awards, and meeting and election of next year's officer will cap off the day.

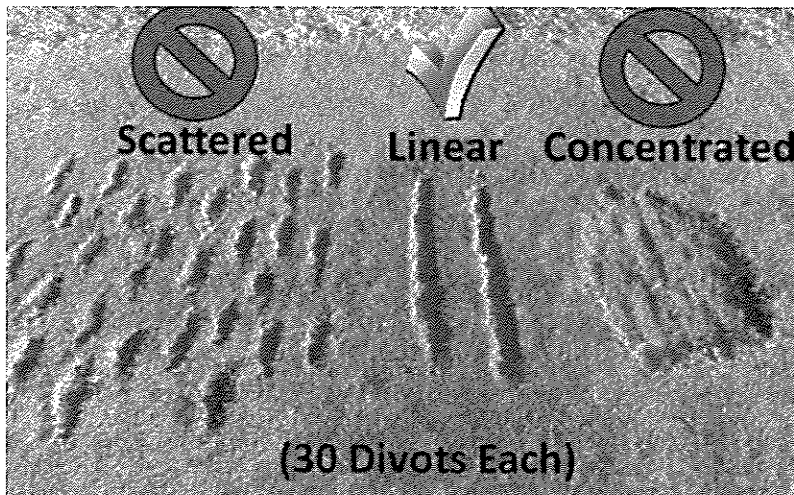
