## **From The Board**


### **Kristen Obush, Club President**

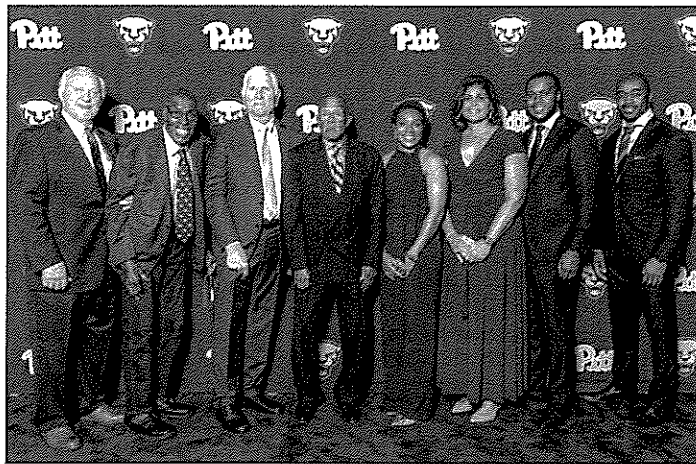

All proceeds from the raffle will go to buy toys from Ligonier's locally owned "The Tree House".

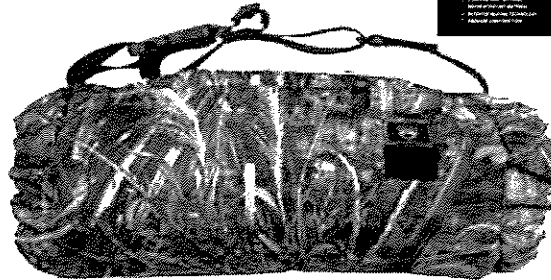

**Prepay for next year's pass by December 31st for just \$700.**





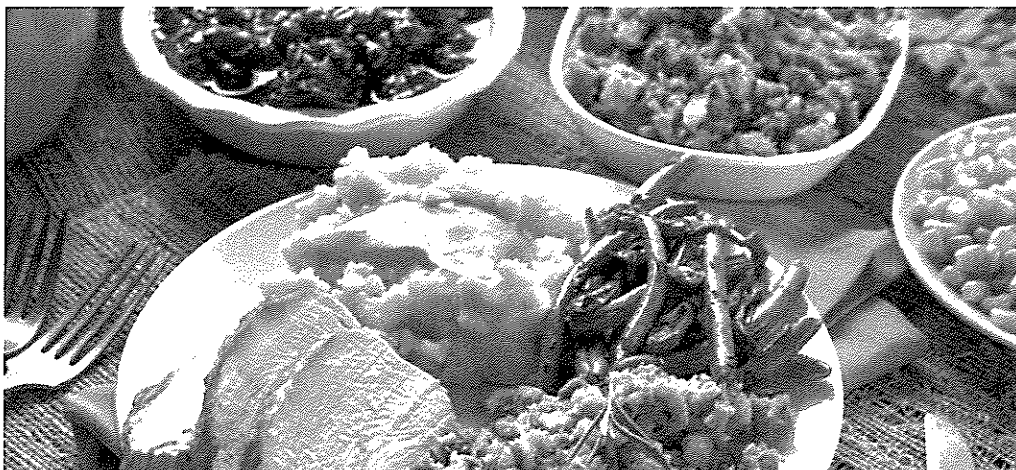
